View Data at a Glance

The School Report Pack for Academy of READING or Academy of MATH offers four reports that display results in user-friendly graphical formats. Each report can be viewed for students, classes, and schools.

Snapshot

Use this primary progress tool to evaluate participation and program results; track progress against targets and facilitate resolution for under-performing students.

Test Results

A pre- and post-test view categorizes student performance levels to help administrators make decisions about who should use the program. The report can help flag which class has the biggest challenge in reading or math by providing class averages relative to grade.

Gains Details

View gains on a per class basis to evaluate which class made the most progress, used the program the most, and achieved the greatest gains. The gains details are a good indicator of performance on state or standardized tests.

Gains Summary

View gains relative to time on task and skills mastered, and the percentage of students who achieved 1, 2, and 2.5 grade level gains. Administrators can quickly compare the percentage of students who are below basic before and after training in the Academy of READING or Academy of MATH to gauge the success of the implementation.
